
More than 9 in 10 people in California live in places with unhealthy levels of air pollution.




Premature death




Health benefits from clean air policies total over \$200 Billion.

Key Recommendation: Local, State, and Federal Agencies

EPA must approve all pending and future waivers in a timely manner for California to realize much needed health benefits of clean air standards.

The governor, California state agencies, local air districts and the legislature must continue strong investments and equitable transition to clean technologies.

Key Recommendation: CA Agencies

Rigorous **enforcement of existing clean air programs** must be a priority for regulators in California to ensure real-world benefits.

Strong alignment across state agencies with clean air and climate standards (e.g. California Air Resources Board, the California Energy Commission and California's transportation agencies).
