

Free TA and training opportunities for states and communities to build sustainable in-home asthma services

Regional Asthma Management & Prevention (RAMP) and the National Center for Healthy Housing (NCHH) are pleased to offer free technical assistance (TA) and training to expand and sustain in-home environmental asthma interventions as part of a new 3-year Cooperative Agreement with the US Environmental Protection Agency.

Our approach to TA prioritizes responsiveness and flexibility over a more prescriptive approach by meeting TA participants “where they are,” building on their organizational and community strengths and needs, and understanding the broader policy and systems context in which they work.

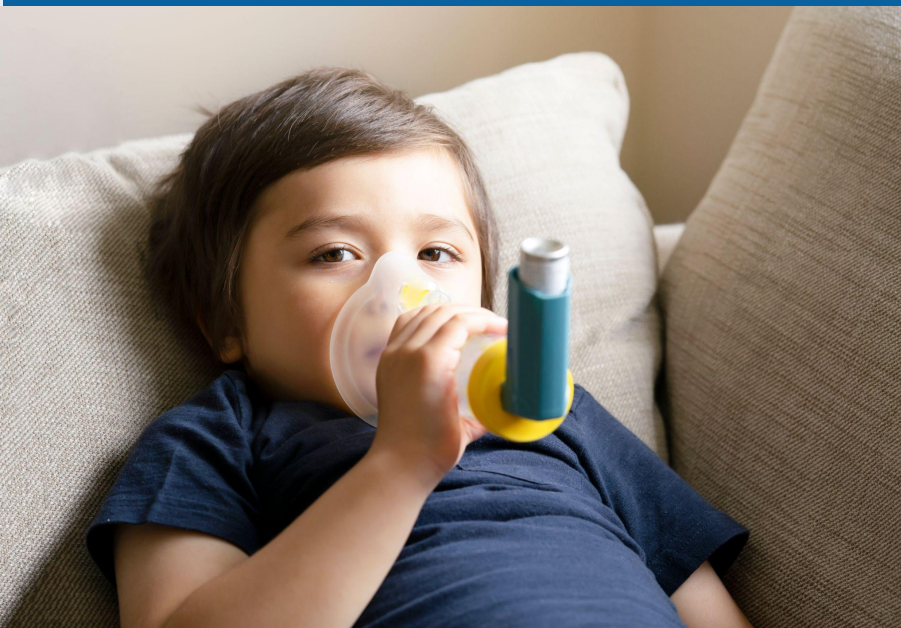
In addition to providing direct TA, we facilitate peer learning opportunities and develop tools in response to identified needs. For example, we developed an interactive tool - [Roadmap to Sustainable Asthma Home Visiting](#)- to support the many ways local champions can approach designing and launching an asthma home visiting program or service.

Examples of our TA include:

- Providing strategic guidance on program and policy development
- Serving as a thought partner in establishing and achieving goals
- Sharing best practices from other programs across the country
- Strategizing to overcome challenges and continue progress
- Facilitating peer-to-peer learning
- Supporting fundraising by identifying opportunities and supporting proposals
- Sharing examples of tools developed by programs across the country
- Helping to develop new tools by providing content and providing feedback
- Conducting presentations to build capacity of TA recipients and their partners
- Highlighting TA partners’ successes to advance the field

Through our previous Cooperative Agreement, we provided [technical assistance \(TA\) to 28 partners across 17 states](#). We’re excited to provide more over the next three years.
